The Second GLOCREd Workshop is to be held at the University of Salamanca on 28th and 29th of May 2020. It will be organized jointly by the staff of CLOCREd (www.glocred.es) and the GLOCRED research group "Economic inequality in contemporary Spain and its effects on markets, firms and access to natural resources and land" (University of Salamanca).

This conference aims to offer scholars, working on topics related with GLOCREd aims, an opportunity to soundly discuss their work in progress. We welcome papers on topics related to the research developed by GLOCREd participating groups. It includes a wide range of topics such as: growth, regional development, international relations, inequality, poverty, technology, energy, finance, and immigration in a historical perspective. Likewise, GLOCREd research projects share a common belief in the relevance of history, economic theory, and statistics in the economic analysis of the abovementioned topics.

Anyone wishing to present a paper should send a 1.000 words abstract by no later than March, 12th, 2020 to: **teresa.forner@uv.es**. Decisions regarding acceptance will be sent out no later than April 3rd, 2020. Final versions of the accepted papers are expected by no later than May 1st, 2020. They will be circulated to all participants prior to the meeting and published on the GLOCREd website. The organizers will cover travel and accommodation in Salamanca (if needed) for those invited to present a paper. Papers by young scholars are especially welcome.

The Scientific Committee will select a limited number of papers accepted for presentation in order to participate in a fast-track process for their eventual publication in Revista de Historia Económica-Journal of Iberian and Latinamerican Economic History.
